







STUDENT'S FEEDBACK ANALYSIS 2018-19




Q.1 To what extent the present curriculum is able to instil critical thinking among the students?


Q.2. To what extent does the course curriculum add to the knowledge and skill of the students so essential for better employability?




Q.3. Library facilities/ Online educational resources /Computer/Internet




Q.4. To what extent the modern teaching aids, power point presentations, web-resources, multimedia, e-content etc. are used by most of the teachers while teaching?




Q.5. To what extent the teachers keep the students updated about the latest developments in the subject/area of knowledge?





Q.6. To what extent the teachers encourage the students to participate in extra-curricular, cocurricular activities and research projects?




Q.7. To what extent you are satisfied with timely coverage of syllabus?
