आज रसायन विज्ञान विभाग की केमिकल सोसायटी एवं विज्ञान परिषद के संयुक्त तत्वावधान में "इनोवेटिव फ्रंटियर्स इन एप्लाइड सांइसेज" विषय पर तीन दिवसीय राष्ट्रीय संगोष्ठी के समापन सत्र में मुख्य अतिथि के रूप में बोलते हुए प्रो.के.बी. पांडेय ने कहा कि मेडिशनल प्लांट के बारे में जब दुनिया जानती नहीं थी। उस समय हमारे यहां के ऋषियों मनीषियों ने आयुर्वेद में बहुत से पेड़ पौधों के औषधीय गुणों की खोज कर इलाज में प्रयोग कर रहे थे। उन्होंने कहा कि एक पौधे के कितने औषधीय उपयोग हो सकते हैं इस पर गहन शोध की आवश्यकता है। आज के वैज्ञानिक जिस पौधे की मेडिशनल प्राप्ती के बारे में बताते हैं कोई जड़ों पर कार्य करता है, कोई तने पर पर, कोई पत्तियों पर फिर भी पौधे के समस्त औषधीय गुणों के बारे हमें जानकारी नहीं

मिल पाती है। नैनो पार्टिकल का उपयोग करते हुए कुछ लाभकारी कंपाउंड लोगों ने बनाया है। बेहतर होगा जो भी रिसर्च हम लैबोरेटरी में कर रहे हैं। उसको लेकर गांवों में जाएं किसानों को उससे कुछ लाभ हो जिससे उनका स्वाभिमान जगे, आत्मविश्वास जगे, नवयुवकों को रोजगार दे सकें तभी हमारे कार्य की उपयोगिता है। उन्होंने कहा हमारे रिसर्च का तभी कोई मतलब है जब देश व समाज के हित में उसका कोई योगदान हो। उन्होंने बताया कि अकेले नीम के अंदर लगभग 150 फाइटोकेमिकल्स निकाले जा चुके हैं जिसके अंदर एंटीबायोटिक, एंटीऑक्सीडेंट, एंटीवायरल, ऐनालजेशिक, एंटीफंगल आदि औषधीय गुण विद्यमान हैं।

समापन सत्र की अध्यक्षता करते हुए के पी.ट्रस्ट के अध्यक्ष चौधरी जितेन्द्र नाथ सिंह ने कहा कि आज पूरी दुनिया गलोबल वार्मिंग की समस्या से परेशान है। हर वर्ष आइसर्वर्ग के पिघलने से समुद्र का जलस्तर बढ़ रहा है एक दिन दुनिया का ज्यादातर हिस्सा जलमग्न हो सकता है। आज जल संरक्षण की नितांत आवश्यकता है। उन्होंने कहा कि एक भी बूंद जल कम नहीं हुआ है बल्कि जल चक्र गड़बड़ हुआ है। उसी को ठीक करने की जरूरत है, वृक्ष एवं जल एक दूसरे के पूरक हैं। जीवाश्म ईंधन भी हमारे पास सीमित मात्रा में हैं, उसके वैकल्पिक स्रोत पर हमें कार्य करना होगा। कालेज के प्राचार्य डा. ब्रजेश कुमार ने कहा कि भारतीय परंपरा पूरी तरह से वैज्ञानिक है हमारे ऋषि मनीषी वैज्ञानिक थे जिन्होंने धर्म एवं प्रवचनों के माध्यम से हमको बहुत सी ऐसी शिक्षा बहुत पहले दी हैं जिनको आज का विज्ञान अभी तक खोज नहीं सका है।

THEME OF THE SEMINAR:

Human Rights are those minimal rights which every individual must have against the State or other public authority by virtue of his being a 'member of the human family' irrespective of any other consideration. Our country was one of the original signatories to the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights and therefore the framers of Indian Constitution were influenced by the concept of human right and recognized as well as guaranteed most of the human rights which were subsequently embodied in the International Covenant 1966. The Constitution of Independent India came into force on 26th January 1950. The impact of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights on drafting part III of the Constitution is apparent. India has acceded to the Universal Declaration of Human Rights as well as to the subsequent International Covenants of Economic, Social and Cultural rights and Civil & Political Rights adopted by the General Assembly of the United Nations.

National Seminar on Human Rights Law will act as a platform for students and other intellectuals from all over the country to come together and discuss various measures to be taken to eliminate discrimination of various forms that is prevailing in present scenario. It is rightly said that no one can change the world in one day but everyone can do their part. This is a small initiative from our side to make world a better place to live in.

SUB THEMES:

SESSION 1: HUMAN RIGHTS OF SOCIAL GROUPS

- LGBT Rights
- Women's Right
- Child Rights

The Seminar was held on 22 February 2019, the Special invitees were Prof. S.C. Roy CNLU, Patna, he was the key note speaker of the seminar, Prof. Siddh Nath, Head and Dean, Faculty of Law, University of Allahabad, Prayagraj and Dr. Murari Verma, Meerut College, Meerut was the special speaker of the inaugural session. The seminar was distributed in three sessions. First technical session was titled “human rights of social groups.” Chairpersons of the session were Dr Rahul Bisariya, Associate Professor, Allahabad Degree College, Prayagraj and Mr. Abhishek Kumar, Assistant Professor, University of Allahabad, Prayagraj. Second technical session was titled “human rights and persons with disabilities.” Chairpersons of the session were Dr Hanuman Prasad, Retired Associate Professor of CMP Degree College, Prayagraj and Dr Ajay Kumar Singh, Assistant Professor, University of Allahabad, Prayagraj. Third technical session was titled “redressal of human rights violation” Chairpersons of the session were Dr. Murari Verma, Associate Professor, Meerut College, Meerut. And Mr. Haribansh Singh, Assistant Professor, University of Allahabad.

It is rightly said that no one can change the world in one day but everyone can do their part. This is a small initiative from our side to make world a better place to live in. The laws and policies of a country can appear to protect human rights but be used in a way that create inequality and actually violate the human rights. This means that the laws of a country must be reviewed and compared to international standards to make clear what impact the laws are having on the rights of their citizens. Legal cases and decisions are just as important as the written laws of a country - regardless of what a law says, what matters is how it is interpreted. The Seminar proposed that an international web site be created that would contain important legal cases from international courts and the courts of individual countries. All cases would be compared to international human rights standards and norms. The web site would also have a user friendly guide to international human rights laws and standards. Individual countries would be responsible for their own web sites which would report cases from their country. This would likely be done by each country's ministry of justice or by other organizations like law schools or human rights bodies. The international web site, which would be a collection of all national sites, would be run by the UN's Office of the High Commissioner for Human Rights.

Seminar participants recognized that there are already many groups that are involved in this sort of review (for example, university departments, social policy agencies and human rights organizations). It was suggested that the expertise and resources of these groups be more focused on human rights issues. Information collected relating to human rights issues could be separately documented and made available in a form that others can understand and share.

The Seminar was focused on the right of Child and concluded on importance that Children are part of an unparalleled effort to establish and maintain a global community based upon universal but evolving standards of human decency, morality and dignity and welfare for children. There are a wide range of laws that guarantee children their rights and entitlement as provided in the Constitution and in the UN Convention of the Rights of their Child. As part of the various plans numerous programmes have been launched by the government for development of Child rights such as Integrated Child Development Scheme (ICDS), Nutrition Component of Prime Minister Gramodaya Yojana, Nutrition Programme for children viz. for Adolescent Girls, Reproductive and Child Health Programme, Pulse Polio Immunization Programme, Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan, National Programme for education of girls at elementary level, Mid-day meal scheme Juvenile justice programme, Scheme for working children, An Integrated Programme for Street Children – Child line Services, The National Rural Health Mission (2005- 12), National Child Labour Projects(NCLP). Prime Minister Narendra Modi launched a small deposit scheme for girl child, as part of the 'Beti Bachao Beti Padhao' campaign etc.

In this seminar we have proposed to study as to what extent the International treaties adopted by States and whether various schemes taken by governments, international organizations/institutions, agencies non-governmental organizations are serving to the real beneficiaries or not? We have also planned to examine whether the welfare scheme made for them have benefited the children or not? If benefited what changes in their status have been brought about into and the requirements of the children which they need for their altogether development.

The seminar was well attended and appreciated by the students and the faculty members of the college.




Dr. Ambalika Sinha explained that stages of research process, The Process of Determining a Research Idea/Problem, Reading Published Articles explained the world of investigators and their work should also be studied briefly to get a better understanding of them, this information gap can be generated by the people who study them. Reading Literature Reviews, these reviews can generate many research ideas that can be used in different ways. The research might be justified because “this particular research issue has not been explored previously or was faulty in application. Replicating Previous Studies, a researcher may replicate the previous studies with modifications in the variables, methodology, use of tools for analysis, statistical methods etc. and may bring out newer insights from the research. Research generally starts with problem identification followed by research questions or objectives formulation. Proceeding from this the researcher determines how best to answer these inquiries and so chooses what data to collect, how to collect, and how it will be analyzed to answer the research question. Formulating a Hypothesis, A hypothesis is a premonition, supposition, doubt, proclamation or an impression about a phenomenon,

association or situation. Research Design, a research design is a plan, structure and strategy of investigation so conceived as to obtain answers to research questions or problems.







Prof. Prabhat Mittal discussed about Correlation is a statistical term describing the degree to which two variables move in coordination with one another. If the two variables move in the same direction, then those variables are said to have a positive correlation. If they move in opposite directions, then they have a negative correlation. Correlation in SPSS is a statistical technique that shows how strongly two variables are related to one another or the degree of association between them.


Prof. Prabhat Mittal also discussed Regression analysis is a well-known statistical learning technique useful to infer the relationship between a dependent variable \mathbf{Y} and p independent variables $\mathbf{X}=[\mathbf{X}_1|\dots|\mathbf{X}_p]$. The dependent variable \mathbf{Y} is also known as *response variable* or *outcome*, and the variables \mathbf{X}_k ($k=1,\dots,p$) as predictors, explanatory, variables, or covariates. More precisely, regression analysis aims to estimate the mathematical relation $f()$ for explaining \mathbf{Y} in terms of \mathbf{X} as, $\mathbf{Y}=f(\mathbf{X})$, using the observations $(\mathbf{x}_i, Y_i), i=1,\dots,n$, collected on n observed statistical units. If \mathbf{Y} describes a univariate random variable the regression is said to be univariate regression, otherwise it is referred as multivariate regression. If \mathbf{Y} depends on only one variable \mathbf{x} (i.e., $p=1$), the regression is said simple, otherwise (i.e., $p>1$), the regression is said multiple.


Prof. Shailesh Kaushal discussed that Parametric tests are those that make assumptions about the parameters of the population distribution from which the sample is drawn. This is often the assumption that the population data are normally distributed. Non-parametric tests are “distribution-free” and, as such, can be used for non-Normal variables. The t test in SPSS. A parameter in statistics refers to an aspect of a population, as opposed to a statistic, which refers to an aspect about a sample. For example, the population mean is a parameter, while the sample mean is a statistic.

Non-parametric tests are “distribution-free” and, as such, can be used for non-Normal variables. The Mann Whitney/Wilcoxon Rank Sum tests is a non-parametric alternative to the independent sample -test. So the data file will be organized the same way in SPSS: one independent variable with two qualitative levels and one independent variable. Prof. Shailesh Kaushal also discussed on Kruskal-Wallis Test etc.




WORKSHOP ON "RIGHT TO LIFE: SPECIAL EMPHASIS ON RIGHT TO EDUCATION"
